

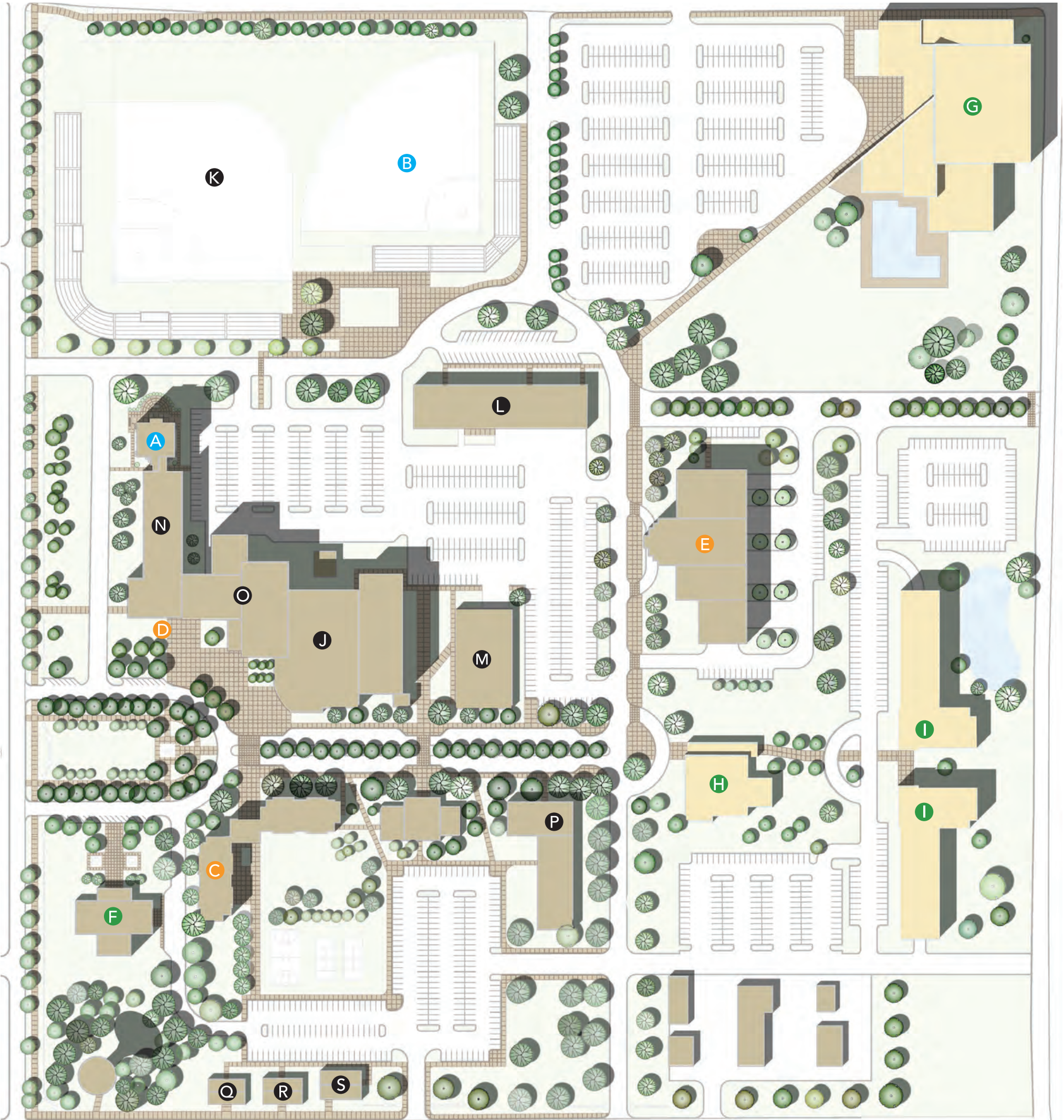

1 million dollar naming opportunity. 1.8 million allocated from state, 500,000 gifted, 1.2 million in Governor's FY11-12 budget.

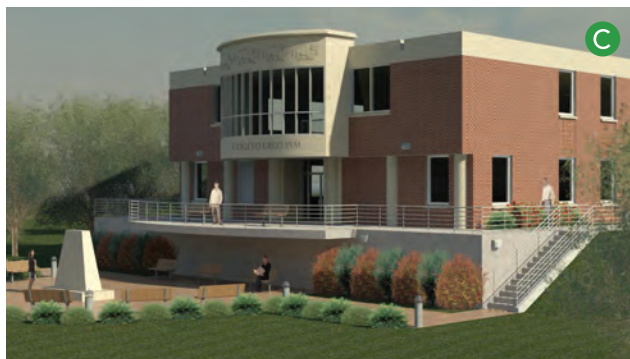
